Dear Colleagues,

It is a great pleasure to invite you all to attend the **23nd Workshop of the International Stroke Genetics Consortium**, hosted by Dr. Yoichiro Kamatani (Univ. of Kyoto and Riken Center for Integrative Medical Sciences) with co-hosts Drs. John Cole (Univ. of Maryland) and Paul Nyquist (Johns Hopkins Medical Center) in Kyoto, Japan on April 12-13, 2018. The meeting is organized by Kyoto University Graduate School of Medicine Center for Genomic Medicine in collaboration with RIKEN Center for Integrative Medical Sciences.

Kyoto, once an Imperial capital of Japan, is now the capital of Kyoto Prefecture as well as one of the major cities of the Keihanshin metropolitan area. It is a particularly appealing city for its traditional environment with countless historic temples, sanctuaries and UNESCO World Heritage monuments that together with its Japanese gardens and the Cherry trees have shaped its architecture as well as its identity. It is host to University of Kyoto, which is known as one of the top Universities in East Asia.

The ISGC is an international collaboration of physicians and scientists who have agreed to pool resources and expertise in an effort to unravel the genetic basis of stroke. It was formed in 2007 by a small group of scientists and has since grown to over 200 members representing over 50 countries in North and South America, Europe, Australia, Asia, and Africa. The success of this initiative stems from the collaboration and engagement of its members, which is best expressed during the workshops where, twice a year, ISGC scientists meet to share their ideas and results.

The workshop will be held over 2 days and will include abstract sessions, working group reports on the progress of the scientific projects and new ideas, as well as invited lectures. The program will include enough time to socialize and explore the city during the social events. The workshop dates fall in the midst of the beautiful cherry blossom season!

So please join us in the beautiful Kyoto, Japan!.



The campus map and information about how to reach the building is available <u>HERE</u> (Building No. 69 in the map).


Shuttle buses will transport the attendees from some hotels to the conference venue on Thursday and Friday morning.

From Kyoto Station or other main train/metro stations (or from anywhere else in Kyoto city), taxi is the easiest way to get to the venue. It will normally cost around \$15 and take around 20 minutes ride, depending on the traffic. Note that the traffic is usually very heavy in April within urban area of Kyoto. Please show the map provided here and point "Kyoto University Yoshida Campus" to the driver.

By bus, there are several options, so please choose carefully. Each bus has its line number, like "17" or "206". Not only one bus line will take you to the same place. Google map has already been finely tuned to Kyoto city, and could efficiently indicate the appropriate one. Detailed bus information is available also at the link above.


MAP-1
Hotel Tokyu Stay Kyoto to International Science Innovation Building, Kyoto University




MAP-2
